I. START AT THE BEGINNING





Sin broke their fellowship with God.

Original Sin.

The tendency to sin, the sin nature, is passed through all the following generations.

2) <u>WE ARE BORN WITH A</u> <u>SIN NATURE</u>

We sin *because* <u>we are sinners;</u> We're not sinners because we commit sin.

Romans 3:23

...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Romans 5:12 (NKJV) ¹² Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned--





THERE'S A BIG COST TO PAY

Isaiah 59:2 (NKJV) ² But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden *His* face from you, So that He will not hear.

<u>Romans 6:23a (NKJV)</u> For the wages of sin is <u>death</u>...

2. JESUS IS THE REMEDY. HE PAID THE COST FOR YOU.

Romans 6:23b (NKJV)

The gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord

ACTS 4:12 (NKJV) ¹² Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." ⁶ Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. *No one comes to the Father except through Me.*

<u>1 JOHN 1: 8-9 (NKJV)</u> ⁸ If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. ⁹ If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

HEBREWS 4:16 (MSG) 16 So let's walk right up to Him and get what He is so ready to give. TAKE THE MERCY, ACCEPT THE HELP.

II. DESIGNED FOR DESTINY, CREATED FOR PURPOSE



Eccl 3:11 (KJV)

(NKJV, NIV, NLT, NASB): He has put *ETERNITY* in their hearts!

(NLT) :¹³ For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him

MSG: ¹⁰⁵ By your words I can see where I'm going; they throw a beam of light on my dark path.

III. COMPLETE OR INCOMPLETE REPENTANCE

Romans 6:23a (NKJV)

For the wages of sin is death...

HAMARTIA

"to miss the mark; to be in error; to fall short."







SINS OF: Omission—not doing what God wants (OMIT)

<u>Commission</u>—doing what God does <u>NOT</u> want (COMMIT)

1 John 3:4 (NKJV) Whoever commits sin commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness

INCOMPLETE REPENTANCE

1. <u>METAMELOMAI</u> ("oh my!") Regret for consequences rather than the cause.

OUTWARD BEHAVIOR



INCOMPLETE REPENTANCE We think NO ONE SEES, so we're fine. *But God sees*



COMPLETE or GENUINE REPENTANCE METANOIA

A Fundamental change in thinking that leads to a fundamental change in behavior and way of living.



My thinking is transformed by HIS GRACE!

Meta: Change Noein: To think Nous: Mind
<u>Jesus commands we repent</u> <u>AND gives HIS grace to</u> <u>repent and change.</u>

<u>Matthew 4:17</u> Jesus began to preach and to say, "<u>Repent</u>.."

Acts 2:37-41 Then Peter said to them, "<u>Repent</u>... be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive <u>the gift</u> of the Holy Spirit." Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.

Acts 3:19 NKJV ¹⁹ Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord

IV. 3 STEPS OF GENUINE REPENTANCE

1. <u>INITIAL</u>—*from what you were born*--sin nature, ADAMIC nature, the "old man"

<u>Romans 5:12</u> Through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned.

2. SPECIFIC REPENTANCE From specific past sins

Acts 19:18 And many who had believed came confessing and telling their deeds. 3.ONGOING or DAILY REPENTANCE. Daily, walk in humility and be receptive to the Spirit

Rev 3:19: As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore, be zealous and repent.



John 8:11: Jesus said, "Go and sin no more."



We are tested to see if we'll run to Jesus.

There are lots of pressures to sin. Christians are swimming UPSTREAM in a DOWNSTREAM world.

TEMPTATION IS NOT SIN

1 Cor 10:13 : No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.

James 4:7: Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

WHAT IF I SIN?

JESUS IS YOUR ADVOCATE

<u>1 John 2:1 (NKJV)...</u>if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.

<u>1 John 1:9</u> If you confess your sins, He is faithful and just to forgive you your sins and to cleanse you from all unrighteousness.

IV. FAITH TOWARD GOD

It's not how big is your faith But *HOW BIG IS YOUR GOD?*

Your sin is not bigger than Jesus and HIS ABILITY to forgive. John 8:10-11 (NKJV) "Woman, where are those accusers of yours? Has no one condemned you?" ¹¹ She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said to her, "Neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more.

LUKE 7: 47-48 (NKJV) ⁴⁷ Therefore I say to you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven, for she loved much. But to whom little is forgiven, the same loves little." ⁴⁸ Then He said to her, "Your sins are forgiven."

<u>JOHN 20: 27-28 (NKJV)</u>

²⁷ Then He said to Thomas... Do not be unbelieving, but believing." ²⁸ And Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"

Romans 10:17 (NKJV)

¹⁷ So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
