III. THE RESULTS? AN ALIVE FAITH! (Acts 3:6-8)
New BOLDNESS
Jesus and the Holy Spirit are of you.
A FURTHER, SEPARATE EXPERIENCE FROM WATER BAPTISM. (Acts 8:8, 14-17, Acts 10:44-48, Acts 19:4-6
1) SAMARIA
Speaking in tongues is the most common resulting sign of having received the Baptism in the Holy Spirit (but not the only sign.)
IV. THIS IS AVAILABLE FOR BELIEVERS (Acts 2:39)
In the Old Testament, the Holy Spirit came upon individuals for specific events. In the New Testament, He is poured out to all
Everyone can receive the gift of speaking in tongues.
The PERSONAL DEVOTIONAL PRAYER LANGUAGE vs.
CONGREGATIONAL OFFICE GIFT. (1 Cor. 14:4-5, 14:39, 1 Cor 14:5 Interlinear Greek- English New Testament, Nestle-Marshall. 1 Cor. 12; Acts 14:5, 18, Ephesians 5:17-18, Jude 1:20)
Interlinear Greek-English New Testament (Nestle-Marshall), 1 Cor 14:5: "Now I wish all you to speak in tongues, but rather <u>in order that</u> ye may prophesy"
Anyone may prophesy in the congregation, but <i>not everyone is a</i> prophet. Any may speak in tongues but not everyone has that as a primary gift in the corporate setting that must have interpretation.

2) THE HOLY SPIRIT HELPS US WORSHIP FATHER GOD. (Acts 10:46, Philippians 3:3, 1 Corinthians 14:15)
3) THE HOLY SPIRIT IS OUR TEACHER. (John 16:13)
4) THE HOLY SPIRIT CONVICTS US OF SIN (NOT CONDEMNATION.) (John 16:8)
5)THE HOLY SPIRIT HELPS US IN SPIRITUAL WARFARE. (Ept 6:17-18, Mark 16:17)
6) THE HOLY SPIRIT GIVES US POWER IN EVANGELISM (Acts 1:8)
VI. HOW DO YOU RECEIVE? (Acts 19:18-20, Deuteronomy 18:9-14 NLT, Luke 11:9-13 AMP, Acts 8:17-18, Acts 9:17, Acts 19:6)
Repent from and renounce any sin and occult activity. Jesus wants to baptize a cleanly prepared vessel.
BE PERSISTENT.
1) Some receive on their own
2) Receive the laying on of hands 3) Begin to praise God out loud. You do your part and He does His.
Cooperate with Him, step out in faith and courage a fresh move of God.
