(2) To the Father in Jesus' Name.
(3)Pray for personal strength.
(4)In confidence (faith), believing He hears you
(5) With a right heart clean from sin

	(2)Lifting and Clapping Hands
	(3)Musical Instruments
	(4)Physical expressions: stand, bow down, kneel, fall down, dance, sing
	(5)Offering Tithes and extravagant giving is an act of worship.
4)	The Benefits of Worship (Acts 13:2, Colossians 3:16, Psalm 8:2, Matthew 21:16b, 2 Chronicles 20:22, Acts 16:25-26, Ephesians 5:19, 2 Kings 3:15-16 NKJV and MSG)  (1) Sensitivity to God's voice and fresh into the Scripture.
	(2)Personal strength, spiritual victory, and deliverance.
	(3)Gifts of the Spirit are released in worship.

A WORLDLY Christian will stop PRAYING;
A PRAYING Christian will stop WORLDLINESS.

When we pray, God listens to our heartbeat.

Hannah's lips moved, but her voice was not heard (1 Samuel 1:12-13).

When we pray in the Spirit, there are groanings which cannot be uttered (Romans 8:26).

Tithes may build a church, but tears will give it life.

Our emphasis is on PAYING, theirs was on PRAYING. When we have PAID, the place is TAKEN. When they had PRAYED, the place was SHAKEN (Acts 4:31). That is the difference between the modern church and the early church.

In the matter of effective praying, never have so many left so much for so few.
